II. Fellowship –“set up the court round about” (v. 6-11)

- B. **Con**_____ –“between the tent of the congregation”
- C. **Con**_____ –“anoint the tabernacle and all... therein”

III. Stewardship –“ put on Aaron the holy garments” (v. 12-16)
