

# "Divine Justice"

No Evilfavoredness Deuteronomy 16:18-17:1

## God ordains:

**I. J**udges – "Judges and officers shall you make" (vs. 18-19) *Justice without:* 

- A. P\_\_\_\_\_- "thou shall not wrest judgment"
- **B. Pa**\_\_\_\_\_- "thou shall not respect persons"
- C. Pay\_\_\_\_\_- "neither take a gift"

**II. J**ustice – "that which is altogether just" (v. 20) *Justice leads to:* 

- A. P\_\_\_\_\_\_ "which is altogether just shall thou follow"
- B. Pr\_\_\_\_\_ "that thou may live"
- C. Pro\_\_\_\_\_ "inherit the land which the Lord thy God gives you"

**III. Judgement** – "which the Lord thy God hates" (vs. 21-22, 1) *Justice that confronts:* 

- A. Im\_\_\_\_\_\_ "You shall not plant thee a grove of any trees"
- **B.** Im\_\_\_\_\_\_ "Neither shall you set thee up any image"
- C. Im\_\_\_\_\_ "wherein is blemish, or any evilfavoredness"
